### Big Win for Wilders

In the Netherlands, the Freedom Party headed by immigration restrictionist Geert Wilders achieved a stunning election victory last month, nearly tripling its number of seats in parliament from 9 to 24, while driving the ruling pro-immigration Christian Democrats down from 41 to 20 seats, forcing the resignation of acting Prime Minister Jan Peter Balkenende. While the centrist Liberal Party, which supports some immigration restrictions, was the big winner with 31 seats, and left-wing Labor won 30, the two do not command a majority in the 150-seat parliament, and are forced to build a coalition government. Wilders, heading the third largest party, has justifiably demanded a role in any coalition. "The political establishment can't ignore us any longer," said Wilders. "We are the biggest winner. More security, less crime, less immigration, less Islam — that is what the Netherlands has chosen."

### Turkish Official Smears Dutch MP

The Freedom Party's elected representative to the European Parliament has demanded an apology from the Turkish Minister for European Affairs. MP Barry Madlener was slandered by Turkey's Minister Egemen Bagis as a "racist" after Madlener questioned him about Turkey's refusal to welcome Freedom Party leader Geert Wilders. In reply, Bagis said Madlener suffers "from a disease that is called racism."

### Defending Patriotism

Marine Le Pen, likely heir to the leadership of France's National Front, criticized immigrant members of the country's soccer team for displaying loyalty to their home countries instead of to France. "I think when you are a representative of France, and notably at the World Cup ... that should be a place where you express your patriotism," she said. "I see players ... expressing their pride in their country of origin. I would like them to express their pride in the country for which they are competing." Player Franck Ribery had himself photographed wrapped in the flag of Algeria, his home country; and team member Nicolas Anelka, another immigrant, said he didn't want to pay taxes to France. In 1998, Marine's father and NF leader, Jean Marie Le Pen, criticized four immigrant team members for refusing to sing the French national anthem at a game.

### China's Military Build-up Provokes Concern

China's expanding military programs in sea and air power are raising concerns at the Pentagon. Admiral Mike Mullen, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff said last month that he is "genuinely concerned" about China's expanded military programs, which he characterized as bristling with "heavy investments" in sea and air power. Analysts say concentration on sea and air power indicate a force projection strategy, strengthening China's ability to conduct military operations far beyond its immediate geographic field of

## Aliens Render California's Work Force Least Educated in U.S.

Because of mass immigration, California now has the least educated labor force of any state in the U.S., according to a new report.

In 1970, immigrants were just 9 percent of the state's population. By 2008, immigrants were 27 percent. A study by the Center for Immigration Studies (CIS) in Washington, D.C. reveals that mass immigration has transformed California from a state ranked as having the 7th most educated labor force into one that is now ranked 50th.

The report, "A State Transformed: Immigration and the New California," by researchers Steven Camarota and Karen Jensenius, ranked the labor force by the percentage of Californians who have completed high school compared to other states. "California has fallen behind the rest of the country," the report said.

"The large relative decline in education in California is a direct result of immigration. Without immigrants, the share of California's labor force that has completed high school would be above the rest of the country," the study found.

The mass immigration flooding the U.S. consists mostly of poor and uneducated populations, the majority from Mexico and Central and Latin America.

CIS said the study's findings are based on U.S. Census Bureau data.

California is already a state with a majority non-white population, and has begun to take on some characteristics more common in Third World countries than in European-derived countries.

"California has become a state with one of the most skewed income distributions and it is among the states with high rates of welfare use and lack of health insurance. Immigrants in the state are six times more likely than

natives not to have completed high school," the report said. "Productivity, standard of living, welfare use, health insurance coverage, and the tax base are heavily impacted by education levels. The low level of educational attainment in the state is likely to create significant challenges for California in the foreseeable future," the report said.

In 1970, California was "right at the national average" in income stratification throughout its population. It ranked 25th in equality of income distribution. But by 2008, it had the sixth most unequal income distribution in the U.S., revealing a trend toward the severe income disparities often found in less developed economies.

California's income distribution in 2008 was more unequal than was Mississippi's in 1970, the report said.

*Middle American News* predicted the coming transformation of California due to immigration back in September 1998. That month's cover story, "Kiss California Goodbye" warned, "uncontrolled immigration, mostly from Mexico

and Latin America, is rapidly transforming its character." Noting the impact of competition between low-skilled native-born American workers and the newcomers -- legal and illegal — the article said, "California's racial imbalance is exacerbated by those economic conditions as they fuel the flight of poor whites from the state. William Frey, a demographer [then] at the Population Studies Center at the University of Michigan, reports that poor and low-skilled white workers are leaving California in record numbers, choosing to settle in neighboring states..."

The CIS study found that "if only native born persons are considered, California would rank 25th in the nation in terms of the share of its labor force comprised of those with at least a high school education, not last."

The transformation of the state will last far into the future. "California ... will not soon close the gap with the rest of the country because immigration (legal and illegal) continues to add large numbers of unskilled workers to the state. Of adult immigrants who

## FBI Links to Leftwing Web Site Promoting Terror Bomber Ayers

The official Web site of the FBI recommends an organization that praises unrepentant terror bomber Bill Ayers, who, as leader of the notorious militant left-wing Weather Underground Organization that set off bombs at the U.S. Capitol, the Pentagon, and police stations, was once on the FBI's Ten Most Wanted List. Ayers has also been identified by an FBI undercover informant as having first-hand knowledge of an unsolved police station bombing that killed one officer and severely wounded others.

Using U.S. tax dollars, under the heading "resources" on its Web page for "Civil Rights" and "Hate Crimes," the FBI provides a direct link to the wealthy Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC), a highly ideologically-oriented left-wing organization that has accused popular immigration control organizations of spreading "hate," and has participated in a national campaign to keep immigration critics such as former CNN television host Lou Dobbs off the air.

The SPLC's Tolerance.org praises Ayers, now a professor of education, as having "developed a rich vision of teaching that interweaves passion, responsibility and self-reflection," and is described as "fighting for social justice."

SPLC's Tolerance.org, in a lesson in "multiculturalism" aimed at children, also recommends that students contact

the radical United American Indians of New England (UAIN) that features on its Web site a letter of solidarity from convicted cop-killer Leonard Peltier to fellow cop-killer Mumia Abu Jamal (a.k.a. Wesley Cook). In 1977 Peltier was convicted of killing FBI agents Jack R. Coler and Ronald A. Williams on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota. Abu Jamal was convicted of the 1981 murder of Philadelphia police officer Daniel Faulkner. Both are regarded as "political prisoners" by radical left-wingers.

Larry Grathwohl, an undercover FBI informant inside Ayers' radical group, testified before the U.S. Senate that Ayers told him fellow radical (and Ayers' future wife) Bernadine Dohrn planted a bomb with his knowledge at the San Francisco Park Police Station in 1970, killing Sgt. Brian McDonnell. Ayers denies Grathwohl's claim.

In February 2009, leaders of the San Francisco Police Officers Association said there "are

compelling reasons to believe Bill Ayers and his wife Bernadine Dohrn, members of the terrorist group, 'Weather Underground' are largely responsible for the bombing of Park Police Station," and urged a "renewed effort ... to bring this case to a close."

Ayers, who describes himself as a communist and dedicated his political manifesto, "Prairie Fire," to Robert F. Kennedy assassin Sirhan Sirhan and other radicals, is unrepentant about his violent activities. He told the New York Times in 2001, "I don't regret setting bombs. I feel we didn't do enough."

Ayers became an issue in the 2008 presidential campaign when his association with candidate Barack Obama was publicized. The two lived in the same Chicago neighborhood, and worked together on a variety of local foundation-funded projects. Mayor Richard Daley confirmed that the two are friends, a description Obama does not deny.

The FBI's link to a group that promotes the views of a radical terror bomber as well as another group friendly to convicted cop-killers, is clearly insensitive to the families of slain police, as well as rank and file officers. Nonetheless, in the new multicultural America, some police departments around the country, apparently including the FBI, rely on the SPLC for information about groups and individuals designated by the SPLC as "hate groups," even if some have only criticized federal immigration policies.

SPLC was an active partner in the "Stop the Hate" campaign launched by the Hispanic chauvinist National Council of La Raza that targeted removing CNN's Lou Dobbs from television. La Raza also called for banning conservative columnist Pat Buchanan from TV.

### Hope Returns to Arizona

Surprise, surprise. USA today reported last month that Arizona's law enabling police to identify illegal aliens "is fueling an exodus of Hispanics from the state..." That reference to "Hispanics" instead of "illegal aliens" is the paper's way of trying to depict the law as a "racist" law. The simple fact is, no Hispanic citizen or legal immigrant would have any reason to flee Arizona. The fact that so many illegals are leaving is welcome news to the people of Arizona. At the overburdened Balsz Elementary School District, the superintendent said that at least 70 students have been pulled by parents out of school. While it is likely the freeloading parents will simply move their offspring to a different state, we hope they'll decide to go back to Mexico where their children are legally entitled to go to school, rather than take up space paid for by American taxpayers and reserved for American children.

### Warning: Constitution May Reflect Dangerous Ideas

Displaying America's new multiculturalist sensibility, Wilders Publications, which reprints copies of the U.S. Constitution, the Declaration of Independence, the Federalist Papers, and other documents central to America's founding, offers this warning to readers: "This book is a product of its time and does not reflect the same values as it would if it were written today." The warning further suggests to parents that they "might wish to discuss with their children how views on race, gender, sexuality, ethnicity, and interpersonal relations have changed since this book was written before allowing them to read this classic work." Wilders Publications, sells some of its products on Amazon.com.

### What Would Thomas Jefferson Say?

One of America's most important officials is calling on the U.S. to imitate a Third World country — Brazil. In remarks delivered at the left-leaning Brookings Institution, Secretary of State Hillary Clinton said America's rich do not pay enough in taxes and that the U.S. should adopt policies being used in Brazil. "Brazil has the highest tax-to-GDP [gross domestic product] rate in the Western hemisphere and guess what — it's growing like crazy. And the rich are getting richer, but they're pulling people out of poverty," she claimed.

### Scholarships for Illegals

A tax-supported community college in California has set up a scholarship fund for immigrants, including illegal aliens. Orange County's Santa Anna College says the scholarships are limited to immigrants, even though the Civil Rights Act of 1964 outlaws discrimination based on national origin. The school also says it will raise money for the scholarship from private sources and won't use any

public funds for the \$2,500 scholarships. The school itself is tax-funded, however. "The fact that a public employee of a public college is seeking to circumvent immigration laws is problematical," said Rep. Dana Rohrabacher, R-CA. "If you have a fund being operated by public employees, it's public." Don't hold your breath waiting for the U.S. Department of Justice — or even California's — to launch an investigation.

### New Resolution, Same Ideology

President Barack Obama, Attorney General Eric Holder, and Secretary of Homeland Security Janet Napolitano have a new ally in their crusade against Arizona's new law that enables police to identify and detain illegal aliens — Communist Cuba. Communists there last month passed a resolution denouncing Arizona's law as "racist and xenophobic" — the same language used by left-wingers in the U.S. Cuba now joins the growing hate campaign launched by left-wingers who control the cities of Seattle, Los Angeles, San Diego, and Austin, Texas, which have passed similar resolutions. Cuba called Arizona's law, which incorporates into state law current federal regulations requiring aliens to carry federal immigration documents, "a brutal violation of human rights." None of the U.S. cities denouncing Arizona have expressed any displeasure over Cuba's own Criminal Code, however. That code criminalizes what it calls "dangerousness," and permits police to imprison citizens who are suspected of being likely to commit a crime sometime in the future, according to "New Castro, Same Cuba," a report from Human Rights Watch.

### Arizona Haters United

In addition to U.S. cities controlled by the left, groups and organizations joining Cuba in denunciations of Arizona and calling for boycotts include the openly racist National Council of La Raza, the National Action Network of anti-white convicted slanderer Al Sharpton, the far left People for the American Way, the Japanese American Citizens League, and the Service Employees International Union, whose vice president, Eliseo Medina, is honorary chairman of the Democratic Socialists of America.

### Unreported Riots

In recent weeks, demonstrations against Arizona by illegal aliens and their supporters erupted in cities across the U.S. as mobs took to the streets in a mass hysteria generated by false news reports in the corporate media that Arizona had become a Nazi-like police state where, as President Obama

## White House to Protect Licenses of Employers Who Hire Illegals

Blocking Arizona's new law that enables police to identify and detain illegal aliens is not the only hostile legal action the Obama regime wants to take against common sense immigration control measures backed by the American people.

As this issue went to press, Secretary of State Hillary Clinton told an interviewer in Ecuador that the Justice Department "will be bringing a lawsuit" against Arizona's new law. But in addition, the regime has already launched another legal action to protect the hiring of illegals.

The regime's legal team has gone to the U.S. Supreme Court in an effort to overturn an appeals court ruling that allows Arizona — and other states — to revoke the business licenses of employers who knowingly hire illegal aliens.

An Arizona law empowers the state to suspend or terminate the licenses of employers who hire illegals, but if President Barack Obama gets his way, businesses that hire illegals won't face punishment.

"If you hire a person in this country illegally knowingly,

you'll lose your license. First offense, 10 days. Second offense, revocation, never to do business in the state of Arizona again," said Arizona state Sen. Russell Pearce, R, who helped write the law.

Hiring illegal aliens is a federal crime, but the Obama government has decided to dramatically scale back enforcement of laws against hiring illegals. Last year, Homeland Security Secretary Janet Napolitano announced that instead of apprehending, detaining

influence. China has been able to spend heavily on military programs thanks to a vast infusion of wealth facilitated by Western corporations that moved manufacturing facilities there to take advantage of cheap labor and relaxed tariffs for goods sent to the U.S.

### Effort to Expel Criminal Aliens

Fearing that a ballot initiative promoted by the Swiss People's Party to deport criminals might succeed, the multiculturalist Swiss government will offer a counterproposal to voters that if passed will let immigrant murderers and rapists stay in the country. In 2008, the Swiss People's Party collected more than 200,000 signatures to place on the ballot a proposed law requiring automatic deportation for any immigrant convicted of a serious felony such as robbery, rape, murder, and drug peddling. But the government wants to limit expulsions, so it has proposed a ballot initiative that would allow a judge to consider the degree of a criminal's integration into his community when deciding whether the criminal should be deported. "For us, the initiative is the only possibility to assure real expulsions. The alternative [offered by the government] is too weak," said Swiss People's Party general secretary Martin Baltisser. "There are too many highly criminal foreigners who are not expelled after a stay in

prison. They are a danger to the country." Leftwing Social Democrat Ada Marra, who supports mass immigration, called the proposed vote "democratic terrorism." The initiatives may appear on a ballot in November.

### Tightening the Noose

Frightened by the growing influence of the Swiss People's Party, European elites are trying to figure out a way to restrict the ability of anti-immigration groups to get their ideas heard — and voted on — in public. In its 2010 report, the European Commission Against Racism and Intolerance expressed worry that "an initiative that infringes human rights can be put to a vote" after a Swiss People's Party initiative to regulate construction of minarets atop Muslim mosques was passed by voters overwhelmingly. The commission then called for stricter enforcement of criminal laws in the European Union against "racism."

### Merger Talk

Germany's two immigration restrictionist parties are polling their members about the possibility of merging. Neither the National Democratic Party (NPD) or the German People's Union (DVU) have been able to garner the requisite 5 percent vote needed to win seats in the national parliament, despite success by the NPD in winning seats in state parliaments. Socialists have been trying to find a way to ban the parties altogether.

and deporting illegal aliens, the Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) would shift resources away from raids on workplaces that hire illegals. Napolitano made the announcement after receiving severe criticism from the leaders of Hispanic advocacy organizations who complained that illegal immigrants were suffering “terror” from being arrested.

“Not enforcing the federal law while blocking states from punishing employers of illegals strongly indicates that Obama supports illegal immigration,” said Robert Goldsborough, president of Americans for

Immigration Control. “It is very likely an integral part of the strategy to reshape the American electorate by letting in as many illegals as possible, and then granting amnesty or creating some other way to let them become citizens so they can vote.”

Arizona’s law is clearly permissible under federal law. It is based on the 1986 immigration act passed by Congress that preempts some state actions on immigration, but with some

explicit exceptions. The law states, “the provisions of this section preempt any state or local law imposing civil or criminal sanctions (other than through licensing and similar laws) upon those who employ unauthorized aliens.”

Kris Kobach, a law professor at the University of Missouri, who helped write Arizona’s recently adopted law enabling police to identify illegal aliens, said Arizona’s licensing law is well grounded. “Congress said very clearly that licensing and similar laws can be used to impose consequences on employers who hire unauthorized aliens at the state level,” he said.

#### BNP Okay Despite Losses

The British National Party suffered a setback when it lost all of its 12 seats on the Barking and Dagenham Council in recent elections, but the details reveal that the BNP’s appeal remains steady. In Dagenham, the number of BNP votes actually increased by more than 2,000. The party also increased its share of the vote in other areas, in Stoke on Trent Central, Oldham West, and Oldham East. In the election, all small parties did poorly against what seemed to be a tidal wave of return by voters to the major parties. Nonetheless, the BNP held up well, and the reason for its earlier successes still exist — which is an increasingly volatile electorate outraged by crime and uncontrolled immigration.

#### Multiculturalists’ Human Rights

France likes to brag that it is the “birthplace of human rights,” a slogan invoked whenever multiculturalist officials want to justify mass immigration. But are human rights really respected in a country where you can be fined and even jailed for expressing opinions contrary to the multiculturalist orthodoxy? In Paris last month, Interior Minister Brice Hortefeux was forced to pay

2,750 euros (more than \$3,000) for remarks he made in reference to a young man of Algerian ancestry. Said Hortefeux: “When there’s one, it’s okay. It’s when there are a lot of them that there are problems.”

#### Your Slurs Bad, Our Slurs Okay

The repression of dissent by Canada’s multiculturalist government took on nearly surrealistic dimensions recently, provoking anger from a Jewish organization when the Toronto Police Service published a report on “hate crimes” that included incidents of slurs uttered against racial/ethnic/religious groups. Toronto police listed an incident in which the Hebrew epithet “shiksa,” a demeaning reference to a non-Jewish woman, was used in a Jewish community against a gentile. In Hebrew, “shiksa” means “a detested thing” and is used to express contempt for female gentiles. The Canadian Jewish Congress was up in arms about classifying the use of shiksa as a “hate crime,” saying the police have gone too far. The chairman of the Police Services Board said the Jewish group was “frankly mystified,” and said the classification was “inappropriate.” Yet Canada’s criminal code allows for hate crime sentencing when there is “evidence that the offence was motivated by bias, prejudice or hate based on race, national or ethnic origin, language, color, religion, sex, age, mental or physical disability, sexual orientation, or any other similar factor.”

claimed, people going for ice cream could be harassed by police and forced to show their “papers.” While many news organizations reported on the protests, many failed to report on the violence. In Santa Cruz, California, illegals and their pals brandishing torches vandalized at least 18 businesses, shattering windows and doors after a May Day rally. In San Francisco, three immigration control activists in a peaceful counter-demonstration were attacked and beaten by Arizona haters. Said one victim who was kicked and punched: “They said we were racists, and that we were against them and against their town ... They said we needed to get out and they called us racists, and that we needed to go home, and then they just attacked my friends and me.” In New York City, one witness reported, “There were young guys with baseball bats and Che [Guevara] signs pinned to their backpacks running down the street smashing store windows, all on the west side of Broadway... There were tons of eyewitnesses, and I even saw a few people videotaping, but of course I can’t find mention of this incident anywhere online or in the media.”

#### Dirt Bags in High Places

In a dictatorial assault on American law and tradition, Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy, appointed to the court by President Ronald Reagan, lead a majority of justices to overturn state laws permitting life sentences for especially vicious violent juveniles. Kennedy claimed the laws were unconstitutional because “international opinion” was against them. “The United States adheres to a sentencing practice rejected the world over,” illustrating “the climate of international opinion” against life sentences without parole,” he said. A majority of states had allowed the life sentences for juveniles, but Kennedy gave greater weight to “international opinion” than to the opinion of the elected representatives of the American people. As a result, juvenile criminals such as Florida’s Nathan Walker and Jakaris Taylor who with their friends gang-raped a woman and forced her to perform oral sex on her 12 year-old son will be eligible for parole, as will Milagro Cunningham, the 17 year-old who beat and raped an 8 year-old girl and left her to die under 197 pounds of rock and trash in a landfill.

#### Immigrant Would-Be Bomber Caught

Another Third World immigrant faces jail for plotting to kill Americans. In a confession that elicited very little attention in the pro-immigration corporate press, a Jordanian national, Hosam Smadi, 19, agreed to plead guilty in federal court on charges he planned to bomb Fountain Place, a 60-story office building in Italy, Texas. Smadi drove a truck he believed contained a bomb to Fountain Place, activated a timer, walked away, and prepared to watch the expected explosion. But the “bomb” never went off because Smadi had been tracked by the FBI and caught in a law enforcement sting operation.



### U.S. Reached Debt Milestone

The U.S. government's total debt of \$13 trillion now surpasses the amount of America's expected gross national product (GNP) in 2012, according to forecasts by the International Monetary Fund. That means America owes more wealth than its entire economy produces.

Analysts say that interest rates will have to increase to convince foreign banks to lend money to the U.S. But higher interest rates could put a brake on businesses trying to pull out of the current recession. "Over the long term, interest rates on government debt will likely have to rise to attract investors," said Hiroki Shimazu, an economist in Tokyo at Nikko Cordial Securities, Inc. "That will be a big burden on the government and the people."

The debt reached \$13 trillion when the Obama administration added \$2.4 trillion in its first 500 days. That's an average debt increase of \$4.9 billion per day, nearly three times the daily average of \$1.7 billion under the previous Bush administration.

"A \$13 trillion debt is an alarm bell and a wake up call combined," said House Minority Leader John Boehner, R-OH. The amount of debt works out to \$42,000 for every U.S. resident.

"Throughout history, excessive debt has led to the demise of great nations," said Sen. Tom Coburn, R-OK. "This milestone should be a wake up call for Congress. No one will bail out America if we continue to live beyond our means."

### No VAT, Says NTU

The National Taxpayers Union has vowed to fight any recommendation by President Obama's "National Commission on Fiscal Responsibility and Reform" that include a VAT, or value-added tax. A VAT is a levy imposed on a product at each stage of its production, which is then added to the price a consumer pays for it. Despite his promise to not raise taxes on anyone

making less than \$200,000, President Obama said his commission must consider that all options "are on the table." NTU Vice President Pete Sepp said the VAT is a huge money-maker for expanding government. "As experience in other countries has shown, a value added tax ... serves as a huge pot of money that allows government to grow even faster beyond its means rather than maintaining a sustainable size."

### You Aint Seen Nothing Yet

The U.S. economy is going to get much worse after January 2011, predicts economist Arthur Laffer, who is credited with the "supply side" economic policies responsible for the economic boom of the 1980s under President Ronald Reagan. Writing in the Wall Street Journal, Laffer said the expiration of the Bush tax cuts at the start of 2011 coupled with scheduled hikes in state and local taxes will spur an economic nightmare. "When we pass the tax boundary of Jan. 1, 2011, my best guess is that the train goes off the tracks and we get our worst nightmare of a severe 'double dip' recession." He said the highest federal dividend tax rate will jump from 15 percent now to 39.6 percent in 2011, and the highest personal income tax rate will go from 35 percent to 39.6 percent. He says that will put a severe damper on new jobs creation and savings. "The result will be a crash in tax receipts once the surge is past. If you thought deficits and unemployment have been bad lately, you ain't seen nothing yet."

### Obama's Judicial Agenda

President Barack Obama makes it clear he seeks to "change" this country's politics and culture. In order to help do that, he needs assistance from the judiciary. And to make this happen with regard to lifetime appointments, the Obama administration is tirelessly pushing left-wing and non-white judicial appointments.

Nearly half of the 73 candidates Obama has tapped for the bench have been women. In all, 25 percent have been African-Americans, 10 percent Hispanics and 11 percent Asian-Americans, USA Today reports. "What's happening so far with nominations is extraordinary," the paper quotes University of Massachusetts Professor Sheldon Goldman, who has tracked the confirmation process since the 1960s. "Seven out of 10 Obama court nominees are non-traditional," meaning they have not been white men.

The nominees are tilting even more leftward, as exemplified by four nominees awaiting U.S. Senate confirmation—Edward Chen, Louis Butler, Albert Diaz and Benita Pearson. Chen, who is up for a federal judgeship, is a one-time American Civil Liberties Union lawyer. In fact, notes Sen. Jeff Sessions, R-Ala., "there is a common DNA among Obama nominees and that's the ACLU chromosome."

Obama, of course, chose ultraliberal Sonia Sotomayor to the U.S. Supreme Court. Now he has nominated Elena Kagan to the same high court. The only good news is that they will replace liberal justices and won't basically affect the court's composition.

There's further good news. More Senate Republicans are finding a spine and blocking or delaying more and more of the nominees. Goldman notes that Obama's trial court picks have been stalled more than such nominees of past presidents. He says the confirmation rate for appeals court justices is also slow. This is probably due to a growing awareness among Republicans that, if they allow the country to continue to slide into socialism with a permissive immigration policy (legal and illegal), their party could be relegated to permanent minority status by the next decade.

Of course, there is precedent for Republicans to cite when it comes to blocking or stalling judges who shape so much of our law and policy. There were shameful smears and delays by Senate Democrats of Bush administration nominees. One that stands out is Miguel Estrada, whose nomination to the influential Washington, D.C.-based appeals court was filibustered by Democrats. The conservative Estrada, who would have been the first Hispanic on that court, withdrew in 2003 after two years of Democrat delays.

Looking ahead to the fall mid-term congressional elections, in which Democrats should lose a significant number of the 59 U.S. Senate seats they now hold, there is every reason for Senate Republicans to continue blocking these Obama "change" agents. The nominees, typified by the University of California-Berkeley professor Goodwin Liu, believe in a "living" Constitution that can be framed and shaped to cover the latest liberal theory. So, if a constitutional republic is to survive the Obama years, combat against these judicial nominees needs to be intensified in the court of public opinion. If the Republican Party is to survive, its lawmakers must not acquiesce to confirming the wide range of Obama judicial nominees.

## Oil Leak Disaster Reveals Obama's Real Nature

The oil tar sludge that has been spreading itself around the Gulf of Mexico for months now is matched by the accompanying opinion sludge working its way through the various media. As at this writing there seems no way of arresting either, I may as well go ahead and inject my own small squirt into the mess.

President Obama's response to the oil and the media disasters has been both incompetent and dishonest—demagogic, actually. Incompetent, because the point the Chief Executive should have made from the onset of the crisis is that a government with the competence (and the money) to handle an engineering problem of such magnitude and technological complexity would be a government with far too much power for any country's good; dishonest, because his appeal to the public, the residents of the Gulf coast in particular, has been one deliberately intended to encourage from it a hypocritical response that does not appear to have come naturally, or been widespread, at the beginning, but rather the opposite.

If the Federal government could identify potential means of plugging the drill hole and successfully apply the appropriate technology to that end, then it would be reasonable to suppose BP to possess the requisite political ability to commandeer the White House and Capitol Hill for the next few months or a year and impose a political climate that would provide the British Driller-in-Chief with the chance to allow the technical solution to succeed. Of course, the government is nearly as much in the dark as the general public is regarding what engineering techniques are applicable 5,000 and 18,000 feet below the surface of the Gulf to halt the oil spill. Only, being the government, it can't admit that it is not omnipotent, as the Democratic opposition claimed George W. Bush's administration ought to have been during and after Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Thus Obama shoved himself immediately into the hopeless position of claiming the Federal government had the situation firmly in hand, while leaving to BP the task of taking practical measures to resolve it. Not very long after the drill rig exploded and

sank, Rudolph Giuliani, speaking on Fox News, offered a list of steps the White House should have ordered at the start, including dispatching flotillas of crude oil tankers from the Merchant Marine to the site to collect the escaped oil. James Carville, the demonic-looking and –sounding Democratic strategist, suggested a few steps of his own. Still the White House, the Pentagon, and Homeland Security sat on their hands. The Coast Guard, they seemed to believe, could take care of whatever BP failed to handle. It is enough to make one wonder whether, in a military emergency, the White House would show itself more prompt and adept in its disposition of the U.S. Navy than it has in mobilizing America's merchant fleet.

Yet, as has so often been the case before with our new President, Mr. Obama's moral hypocrisy is more shocking still than his political and strategic incompetence.

The fisherman, hoteliers, restaurateurs, and other residents of the stricken Gulf are to be pitied, of course. Yet to portray them as victims of Big Oil and Faustian technology, as Obama is doing, is a profoundly unrealistic and dishonest strategy. Fishing boats and shrimpers are powered by petroleum, and so are the automobiles that bring millions of tourists to the Gulf every year. So are the pleasure boats that populate the yacht basins along the coastline. Many of the hotels and restaurants are heated by oil, as are a large percentage of private homes. The oil that BP was seeking to produce was intended for the people of the Gulf states, just as much as for people in other regions of the United States, and abroad. Demagogue that he is, the President has been speaking to the nation as if nearly everyone alive in the world today were not complicit in the development and, often enough, the exploitation of nature and nature's resources. Very much to their

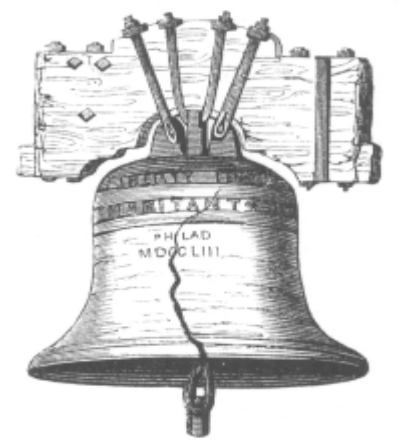
credit, the residents of the Gulf seem to be well aware of the reality. Many of them indeed, whether quoted in the newspapers or interviewed on television, have expressed that awareness in explicit terms. Louisiana's economy is based on far more than shrimping, sport fishing, bait shops, beaches, and rum cocktails. If the Federal government were to ban offshore drilling in the Gulf on a permanent basis, the economic result would be enormous, perhaps even catastrophic. As things stand, the President's declaration of a drilling moratorium in Gulf waters is being widely protested by the local residents, who can foresee exactly what the impact upon their livelihood will be in the near future.

The New York Times, not to be outdone in bathos by the White House, printed a front-page story about the woes of Florida, a state that, in a supposedly virtuous decision, long ago chose pristine beaches over offshore drilling. But what goes for the Gulf states goes for the Sunshine State as well. Florida's historically uncontrolled development and its lavish over-use of resources (in particular for air-conditioning) ensure that the oil it decided not to produce offshore must come from other states—like Louisiana. If anyone in Florida is entitled today to shed alligator tears over the oil tar threatening to wash up on Floridian beaches, it is assuredly the alligators of the Everglades, not the human population.

But, as with the Gulf states, the indignation on behalf of poor Florida

appears to emanate from the White House and the New York Times, not from the Floridians themselves. Perhaps the most repulsive aspect of the entire Gulf catastrophe is President Obama's deliberate encouragement of the American public to think even more irresponsibly than so large a portion of it (more often than not the liberal portion) actually does. Just when Obama professes to be attempting to encourage Americans to view their country, its problems, and its future more realistically than he believes they are in the habit of doing, the President has insisted on laying the blame for the Gulf spill relentlessly, and almost exclusively, on the greedy management of a "British" (actually multinational, but, in any case, largely foreign-owned) company. Does Obama not see that, by doing so, he is encouraging the American public to believe that it can, or should, be able to have it both ways: plenty of oil, with clean beaches; unlimited natural power, without a natural price. This is the reason why Obama's environmental constituency is so angry with his response to the disaster, and with him. Despite a reference, every now and again, to the need the BP spill demonstrates for "alternative energy" sources, the President has gone "off message," as the moles in the administration say. And he has done it to save his political hide.

Here, at last, is change we can believe in. The emperor has traded his campaign finery for simple nudity, and the lordly professor has turned — *Presto!* — before our eyes into a grimy career politician.

**Obama's Katrina** While boldly proclaiming that he has been "in charge" of the Gulf of Mexico oil spill "since day one," Barack Obama continues to dodge his responsibilities and remains typically clueless and impotent in resolving the disaster. It is moronic to believe that Big Government has the competence and expertise to restructure America's entire health care system, reform Wall Street and banking practices, effectively fight militant Islam without even calling the enemy by its right name, bail out union pension programs, run General Motors, control our national debt while continuing to finance Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid, Food Stamps, welfare and other "entitlements" and socializing virtually every aspect of our economy — when it can't even begin to plug one leaking oil well and clean up the mess.

## Immigration Briefs

*A news summary from Americans for Immigration Control*

**Most Americans support Arizona's law** that allows state and local officers to arrest illegal aliens. A CNN/Public Opinion poll found that by a margin of 57 percent to 37 percent, Americans endorse the new law. The poll also found that 82 percent of Americans oppose the economic boycott of Arizona promoted by illegal immigration advocates. Other findings of the poll: Sixty percent want to stop the flow of illegal aliens into the U.S. and deport those here; seventy-one percent want to fine employers of illegals tens of thousands of dollars; and eighty-eight percent want more federal agents assigned to the U.S.-Mexican border. **Fifty-eight percent of U.S. voters oppose our country's current policy** of giving automatic citizenship to the children of illegal aliens born on U.S. territory, according to a poll conducted in June by Rasmussen Reports. Advocates of the present policy cite the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Constitution to uphold their position. The amendment states, "all persons, born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States."

Opponents of this interpretation say it is inaccurate because illegal aliens and their children are foreign nationals, and are therefore not subject to the jurisdiction of the United States. As evidence, they note that the framers of the amendment excluded from citizenship U.S.-born members of Indian tribes, then regarded as nations separate from the United States. The purpose of the amendment was to guarantee citizenship to newly-freed slaves. Source Rasmussen Reports 6/3/10

**Arizona State Senator Russell Pearce plans to introduce legislation** to deny birth certificates to the children of illegal aliens born in the state. Pearce is also the author of the legislation recently passed in Arizona to crack down on illegal immigration.

The senator disagrees with the federal policy of giving automatic citizenship to the children of illegal aliens born in the U.S. Said Pearce, "It is difficult to imagine a more self-defeating legal system than one that makes unauthorized entry into the U.S. a criminal offense and simultaneously provides [U.S. citizenship] the greatest possible inducement to illegal entry." He added that the children "are citizens of the country of their mother."

Legal authorities say that a state law like the one Pearce proposes could serve to create a legal challenge to the existing federal policy. Source: *The Arizona Republic* 6/3/10

**Financial and economic journalist Robert Samuelson observed** that the official poverty level in the United States, around 12 percent, has not declined during the past forty years. One reason is immigration, which, in his words, "has increased reported poverty." He went on to point out that "Many immigrants are poor and low-skilled. From 1989 to 2007, about three-quarters of the increase in the poverty population occurred among Hispanics—mostly immigrants, their children and grandchildren."

Samuelson said that poverty "experts" don't like to mention immigration because that would imply "that more restrictive policies might reduce U.S. poverty." Source: Real Clear Markets 5/31/10

**Former mayor of New York City, Edward Koch, supports a high level of legal immigration**, but is strongly opposed to amnesty for illegal aliens, i.e., granting them legal status and a pathway to citizenship. Said Koch, "[T]he U.S. should not reward illegal immigration. To provide amnesty only encourages people to come here illegally, hoping that we will continue what is becoming a tradition of granting amnesty. . . ."

He observed that the Obama Administration may try to pass an amnesty after the November elections "when they think the public is powerless to do anything about it." To avert this outcome, Koch called on citizens to "Get your U.S. representatives and senators to pledge to oppose 'amnesty and a path to citizenship' for illegal immigrants. ## THE THIRD WORLD COMES TO AMERICA



### Mexican Drug Gangs in Control

Thanks to the failure of the federal government under numerous presidents to protect the border, Arizona has begun to succumb to the Third World. ABC15 News in Phoenix reported last month that "Mexican drug cartels now control parts of Arizona." Pinal County law enforcement say an area known as the "smuggling corridor" that stretches from Mexico's border to metropolitan Phoenix is no longer under Arizona's control. Night vision police surveillance cameras have photographed drug cartel gangsters armed with military weapons delivering drugs to vehicles along a main highway. "We are outgunned, we are out-manned, and we don't have the resources here locally to fight this," said Pinal County Sheriff Paul Babeu. The area was once a recreational resource for family hiking and off-road vehicles. But now the government, which can't protect visitors, has posted signs warning citizens that the area is rife with drug smugglers and human traffickers.

### A 'Civilized' School?

A convicted sex offender enrolled in Roosevelt High School in North Seattle was charged with raping a developmentally disabled girl. The accused is Jose Reyes, an 18 year-old junior at the school who was convicted in 2007 of taking indecent liberties with force. One would have thought that in a civilized society, convicted sex offenders would not be eligible to attend school with under-age girls. But could it be that civilization wanes as parts of the U.S. succumb to the Third World?

### Third World Competence

In enforcing basic immigration law, the federal government is about as reliable as any Third World government. In Edmonds, Washington, an illegal alien arrested on rape charges was found to have been previously deported *nine* times. Police said the illegal alien, Jose Lopez Madrigal of Mexico, had a long list of arrests and convictions, as well as 30 different aliases. Madrigal was convicted of armed theft in California, arrested for drug sales in San Diego and San Francisco, and arrested for drugs again in Stockton, and pleaded to third degree sexual assault in Denver. Immigration and Customs Enforcement refused to comment on the case, according to local news reports.

### Attackers Voice Multiculturalist Resentments

In Seattle, a white teenager was robbed and beaten by two non-white men who victimized him for four hours, using his belt to whip him while they told him, "How do you like it, white boy?" and "This is for enslaving our people." The victim said his tormentors burnt him with lit cigarettes and urinated on him.

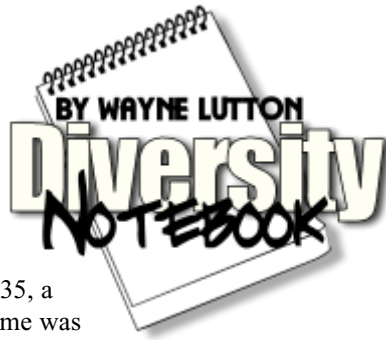
**Roadway Death Toll Mounts**

Scarcely a day goes by without Americans being killed by foreign drivers. Fellow citizens who were not with us to celebrate July 4<sup>th</sup> include:

\*An 18-year-old woman crossing the street at Roosevelt Road and California Avenue in Chicago was struck and killed, police said, by Jorge Quintas, 35, a citizen of Mexico. The young female's name was not released pending the notification of her family.

Quintas is charged with reckless homicide and drunken driving. Witnesses said Quintas sped through a red light before hitting the woman. She hit his windshield and he drove off. A tow truck driver followed his car and alerted police, who said they found him in a Dodge Stratus reeking of alcohol. Police reported that he had rear-ended another car shortly before running down the woman.

\*In Paris, Wisconsin, Jorge Dominguez, 38, a previously convicted drunk-driving illegal alien from Mexico, was arrested and charged with a hit-and-run car crash that killed Dawn Glogovsky, and injured her husband and 13-year-old son. According to police reports, Dominguez admitted to drinking eight beers before he took off in his car and eventually sped into the Glogovskys as they were driving home. Dominguez has been charged with drunk driving in Illinois and possession of cocaine in past years. But after serving time in prison he was not deported. Instead, he was released back onto the streets, where police said he killed this Kenosha County wife and mother.



\*Manuel Contreras-Galdean, 33, an illegal alien from Mexico, was sentenced to 14 years in prison after pleading guilty to one count each of manslaughter and aggravated assault. Contreras-Galdean, who was driving with a blood-alcohol count two-and-a-half times the legal limit, and was also on cocaine, ran into and killed Kelly Tracy, 16, and injured her brother, Matthew Tracy, 17, as the teens were driving to Highland High School in Mesa, Arizona. He has prior DUI convictions in Utah in 2001 and in Tempe, Arizona, in 2007. But after being deported, Contreras-Galdean returned to Arizona, where he continued to use drugs and drink and drive, leading to the death of young Kelly Tracy.

\*Javier Correa, 28, a suspected illegal alien from Mexico, was charged by police for the hit-and-run death of 13-year-old Kendrick Owens in New Caney, Texas. Police report that the Keefer Crossing Middle School student was walking home with a friend when Correa struck and killed him. News reports said Correa fled the scene but a truck driver who saw him hit Owens followed his Dodge Dakota and alerted police. Correa has been charged with intoxicated manslaughter and has previous convictions for assault in 2000 and a DWI in 2005.

\*Rwandan national Ngere Omari, was drunk when he drove the wrong way on Interstate 5, near Seattle, Washington, and crashed head-on into a car driven by 20-year-old Heather Lee Meadows. Meadows was killed instantly and her passenger, Eric Gray, was seriously injured. At the time of the fatal crash, Omari was on probation and had a suspended license for a previous DUI. Convicted of vehicular homicide, Omari was sentenced to only six years in prison. And he will not be deported to his African homeland, since he has been granted political asylum due to Rwanda's civil war. Prosecuting attorney Amy Freedheim said that a more severe



sentence was warranted in this case: "She was a wonderful young woman and our community suffered a loss that was completely unnecessary."

**India Secures U.S. Military Technology**

Once again, the U.S. Defense Department permitted foreigners to obtain classified military technology. Parthasarathy Sudarshan and Mythili Gopal, both citizens of India, were convicted in federal court of violating the Arms Export Control Act by purchasing U.S. electronic components used in missile guidance and firing systems and for jet fighter production. Sudarshan and Gopal set up a company, CirrusUSA, based in Simpsonville, South Carolina. CirrusUSA secured the military components and then shipped them to Cirrus Electronics in Singapore. From there, the devices, including high-tech capacitors, semiconductors and resistors—all with missile applications—were delivered to the Vikram Sarabhai Space Center, an Indian government manufacturer of space launchers and missiles. Although federal prosecutors noted that the components could be used in nuclear missiles, the Indian duo received only 4-year sentences.

**Dangerous "Bushmeat" Entering Through NYC**

Two strains of simian foamy virus have been found in hundreds of dead monkeys, chimpanzees, great apes, rodents, and bats coming through luggage and mail parcels in New York City. Referred to as "Bushmeat," the contaminated carcasses were shipped as food for Africans and Asians living throughout the U.S. Officials at a university symposium on "Wildlife Conservation & Human Health," testified that humans can contract simian foamy virus. They worry that this could mutate into another AIDS-like epidemic.

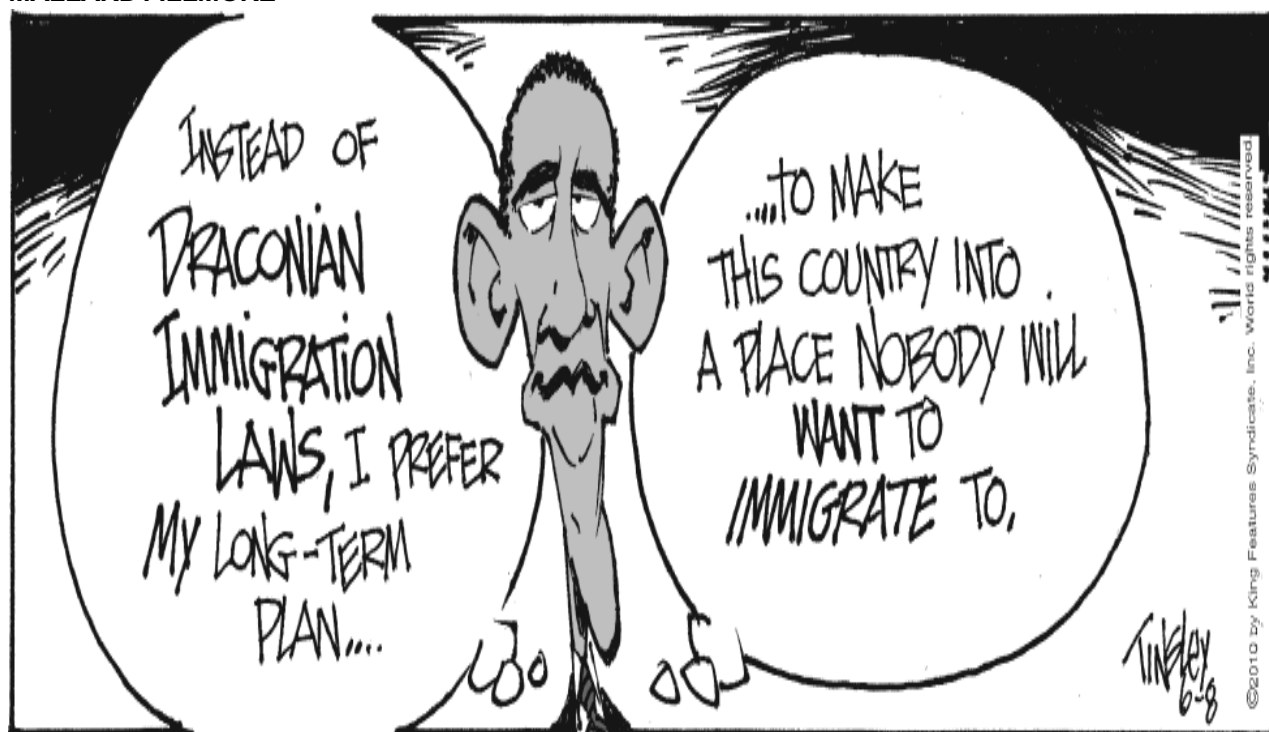

**Stonewall.** Rep. **Lamar Smith (R-TX)** says the Obama Justice Department is refusing to cooperate with Congress on oversight of at least three serious issues — allegations of criminal misconduct by ACORN, the department's dismissal of racial voter intimidation

Legislation has been introduced by Sen. **Mary Landrieu (D-LA)** to make sure both sets of plunderers are treated equally — while continuing to openly discriminate against white males, of course — but it's an issue few pols want to discuss during an election year . . . .

**Welfare Good, Defense Bad.** A gaggle of "diverse" politicians is demanding massive, trillion-dollar cuts in defense spending to avoid trimming constantly exploding expenditures on welfare, foreign aid, social engineering and other terrible ideas.
